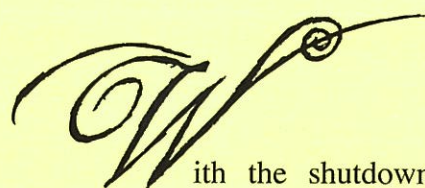


Franklin:
The Era of the Camp Family

With the shutdown of International Paper's Franklin Mill in 2010, this small town on the western edge of Tidewater, saw the closing of an era of prosperity that began over 100 years ago with the foundation of Camp Manufacturing Company. Established by P.D.Camp and his brothers, this small lumber mill grew into an internationally acclaimed manufacturer of fine paper, providing livelihoods, both blue and white collar, for families in the surrounding counties and northeastern North Carolina. Known for their generosity and philanthropy, members of the Camp family have always felt a responsibility for the well-being of the area, funding the local community college, the city library, the YMCA, the public safety building and numerous other buildings and organizations in the region. The support of the Camp family continues through the foundations they established.

Visitor Guidelines:

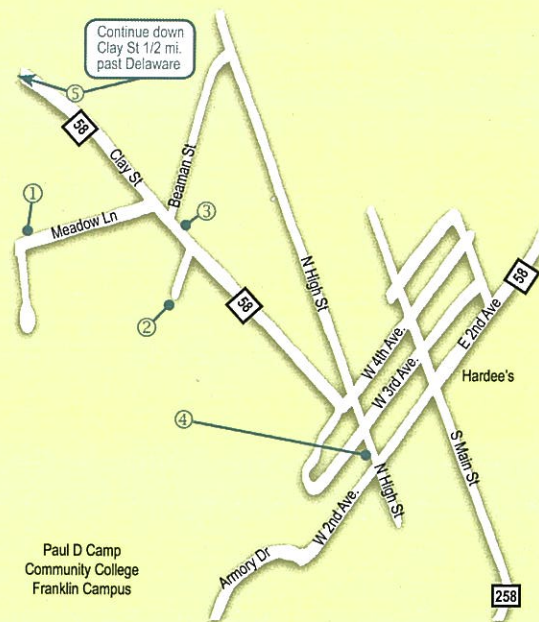
