Officers responded to an alarm at the Chamber of Commerce, upon arrival the front door was open and a side window was observed to be broken out. The building was checked with no one found inside and nothing was taken. It is believed that the alarm scared the suspects away.

Officers also found Britt & Peak to have been burglarized with the suspects gaining entry through the back door. The suspects vandalized the inside of the building and stole drinks and snack food items. Evidence was recovered from inside the business, video evidence was also recovered showing several suspects involved in the crimes.

Event: Armed Robbery

Officers responded to an armed robbery at Deli Express. Upon arrival, it was learned that an employee, who had closed the business for the night, was accosted outside by two suspects. One suspect grabbed the employee from behind then the second suspect pointed a gun in the employee's face. The victim was robbed of his wallet which contained an undetermined amount of cash and his cellular telephone.

The victims are described as black males, 20 to 25 years old, approximately 5' 7" with medium build. The suspects were wearing black bandanas over their faces and were dressed in dark clothing. After robbing the victim, the suspects fled on foot toward Chestnut Street.
